Bat researchers, managers, and enthusiasts are invited to a landscape-scale mist-net survey for bats in northeast Tennessee.



Each night, teams of volunteers will sample a diversity of sites. Over 40 sites will be surveyed during the 3-night effort.

The 6<sup>th</sup> Annual SBDN Bat Blitz will be an effective way to collect bat distribution data using a variety of techniques. Added bonuses are beautiful Blue Ridge Mountain scenery, camaraderie and fun.

Target species: *Corynorhinus rafinesquii*, *C. townsendii virginianus*, *Eptesicus fuscus*, *Lasionycteris noctivagans*, *Lasiurus borealis*, *L. cinereus*, *L. seminolus*, *Myotis leibii*, *M. lucifugus*, *M. septentrionalis*, *M. sodalis*, *Nycticeius humeralis*, & *Pipistrellus subflavus*.
